TOWN OF BALL MARDI GRAS PARADE RULES

- ❖ Mardi Gras parade float riders must be dressed in appropriate Mardi Gras attire which utilizes any combination of the traditional colors of purple, gold, or green. Float riders should wear masks.
- * Riders may not solicit vulgar, obscene, and/or pornographic acts in exchange for throws.
- Throws are prohibited that are vulgar, obscene, pornographic, and/ or dangerous

"Dangerous" is defined as:

- Any object which is overly heavy to the extent that a spectator could likely be injured, simply by attempting to "catch" said throw.
- Any object that could be considered a knife, sword, or similar type implement and any object that has sharp edges, to the extent that a spectator could likely be injured, simply by attempting to "catch" said throw.
- Crossing barricades without police permission is *PROHIBITED*.
- Candy WILL BE allowed as throws.
- Any Parade Participant who violates any rule will be subject to sanctions including being banned from the parade and forbidden to participate in future Mardi Gras parades.

Parade route begins at Powell Dr. and ends at Shanghai Rd. Line up begins at 12:30 pm, no later than 1:00pm due to road closure.
