- 11. Motion by Alderwoman Covington, seconded by Alderwoman Bishop to rescind a motion made at the regular council meeting held on June 18, 2013 related to pay per call for weekend first responders. The floor was open for public comment. On vote 3-0, the motion carried.
- 12. Motion by Alderwoman Covington, seconded by Alderman Robertson to approve Zachary Wug as a Reserve Officer. The floor was open for public comment. On vote 3-0, the motion carried.
